Juanita Edington c.920-988-2416/h.206-6111 jaemusiclover@gmail.com As we have been sharing in-person worship, it continues to be recommended to have congregational singing only when masked and appropriate distance between family groups (The Hymn Society recommendations). We need to remember that while many may be vaccinated in our congregation, there are those who are not yet eligible to receive vaccines, or cannot, for various reasons. Aerosols expelled by singing move outward farther than those of ordinary breathing or talking.

- We are seeking your offering of musical gifts for our worship. We would like to continue the practice of sharing music in a safe way to enrich our worship. The plan includes a solo vocalist leading the hymns for the day at a safe distance, unmasked and with a microphone for clarity for the in-person congregation and the congregation attending on-line.
- Would you be interested in leading the hymns during worship on a Sunday? Would you be interested in sharing a musical offering? I am looking for musicians to serve our church by sharing their musical gifts. The musical offering can be vocal or instrumental. Please contact me if you would be interested. Thank you!

Hymn Insights

- Recently Susie Krueger played "Many and Great"
- <u>for a prelude.</u> This was based on a hymn of the same name, which has not been sung in our congregation, but is #3 in the New Century Hymnal. The information tells us the hymn tune name is LACQUIPARLE, it is a Native American Melody (Dakota nation), adapted by Joseph R. Renville in 1842, harmonized by James R. Murray in 1877, and paraphrased by R. Philip Frazier.
- Additional information states, "Probably the best known Native American hymn, "Many and Great" is sung with great reverence by the Dakota people in worship, at communion, and for births, funerals, and burials. Renville helped establish the Lac qui Parle mission in Minnesota. Frazier, a Native American, was a Congregational minister." A second text is found on #341 NCH.
- Also recently, Melissa Mattke focused on Fanny J. Crosby during her Family Time. We found out that there are 5 of her poems (hymn text) in our hymnal. Just a week or two earlier, we had sung one of Ms. Crosby's hymns, "Blessed Assurance" #473 NCH. "After hearing Phoebe Knapp play this tune on the piano, Fanny Crosby composed the poem on the spot.
- In her almost 95 years, Crosby wrote more than 8,500 gospel songs!" She could trace her lineage back to the Puritans who arrived in Massachusetts in 1635, her music was very popular in the revival circuit, and as publishers of hymnals didn't want to have too many songs by one author, she wrote under many pseudonyms.
- There are many other fascinating facts about her life, so I would encourage you to do some digging to find out more.


